Rally Marshals Registration

Details of the new scheme and training modules will be launched at Autosport International in January. Anyone interested in marshalling on rallies and specifically stage rallies are strongly recommended to register within 2015. The advantage in being registered by start Jan 2016 is that the mandatory training can be undertaken at any time within 2016. New registrations in 2016 will need to complete the training before "registration" can be completed and therefore could be subject to some delays.
