Classic Car Enthusiast,

The Sporting Car Club of Norfolk invites you to join us for our Midsummer Classic Car Run.

This year we will be starting at the Hingham Sports and Social Club. At the moment we are unable to give details of the finish venue but as and when we know the full details they will be published on the web pages (www.sccon.co.uk).

This year's route will be about 80/90 miles long.

We are keen to attract a good number of cars, so the route will be free flowing to suit older vehicles while still avoiding A-roads when ever possible. If you are not to sure that your vehicle is eligible for the run, please contact us.

This is not a speed event; it is designed to be a leisurely drive through the countryside.

You do not need to be a member of the Sporting Car Club of Norfolk to enter this event.

At the start you will be supplied with a rally plate for the front of your car and a route book in our popular easy-tofollow format. A memento will be given to every car that completes the run.

The first cars will start leaving the start at 9.30am and the timing will be relaxed, allowing sufficient time to enjoy the various sites of interest along the way.

This year we will be making a charity donation to local charities including the East Anglian Air Ambulance on behalf of everyone taking part or supporting the Classic Run. There will be opportunities to give donations to the charities throughout the day.

At the start venue you and your party will be welcome to a free tea or coffee, and you can purchase a breakfast (bacon rolls etc) before you leave.

We will post any news in the final instructions and on the SCCON web site, we hope to be able to offer reduced entrance fees to some of the venues we are visiting this year.

REGULATIONS

Definition (the boring bit where we have to cover the technical bits).

- 1 The Midsummer Classic Car Run 2011 is a Touring Assembly for passenger cars.
- 2 The event, which is not competitive, will take place on SUNDAY 19th JUNE 2011.
- 3 The organiser and promoter is the Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Limited
- 4 The event is organised under a Certificate of Exemption issued by the Motor Sports Association.
- 5 By applying to enter, all participants undertake to comply with these regulations and any additional instructions issued by the organisers. Such additional instructions will have the same power as these regulations.
- 6 The Clerks of the Course have absolute discretion in the application and amendment of these regulations, breach of which may result in exclusion from the event.

<u>Route</u>

- 7 The route will start at the premises of Hingham Sports and Social Club.
- 8 The route will include check points, which will be specified in the route book given to each participant. Check points will only be open between specified times.

Eligible Vehicles

- 9 The event is open to all three and four wheeled motorcars manufactured up to 1984. Cars manufactured after this date, heavily modified cars, kit cars and light commercial vehicles may be accepted at the discretion of the organisers. Such decision will be based on an assessment of the historical interest of individual vehicles. Owners of such vehicles are requested to consult with the organisers prior to submitting their entry. Heavy commercial vehicles, agricultural vehicles and motorcycles are not permitted.
- 10 All vehicles must have valid insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act, a valid DoT Test certificate and be licensed for use on the public road. Trade plates are not permitted. It is the responsibility of each participant to ensure that the vehicle used is in roadworthy condition.
- 11 The maximum number of starters for the event is 125 and the minimum is 50. If the minimum number is not achieved, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.
- 12 Participants will be provided with numbered identification plates, which must be clearly displayed in a forward facing position near the front of the car. No other numbers may be displayed, other than the vehicle registration number.
- 13 No advertising, trade sign or promotional display may be carried on or distributed from any vehicle without the organisers' consent.

Eligible Participants and Drivers

- 14 Entry may be made by any person over 17 years of age. (but must hold a full drivers licence)
- 15 Only drivers named on the entry form may drive on the event.
- 16 Passengers may be carried up to the maximum number for which proper seating is provided. This year dogs may be carried but please keep them under control and well away from other cars at all checkpoints.

Entries

- 17 Entries open upon publication of these regulations and close on 12th June. The entry fee is £25.
- 18 Entries must be on the official entry form (feel free to copy the forms for a friend), which must be signed by the participant and all persons who may drive, and sent to:

- 19 Cheques must be made payable to Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd
- 20 Acceptance of entries will be at the discretion of the organisers.
- 21 A request to withdraw from the event must be made in writing. The entry fee will then be returned less £2 administration charge.

Documentation, Eligibility and Scrutineering

- 22 In the week prior to the event, final instructions including directions to the start and individual starting times will be posted to all participants.
- 23 Before starting the event, participants will be required to sign an indemnity and a declaration stating that their vehicle is insured in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act for all persons who will drive the vehicle, has a valid DOT test Certificate and carries a valid vehicle license disc, and that all persons who will drive hold a valid full driving licence for the vehicle to be driven.
- 24 Any vehicle that does not comply with these regulations or is deemed inappropriate for the event will not be allowed to start.

<u>Start</u>

25 Cars will leave the start at regular intervals with the oldest cars departing at 09.30. Participants must arrive at the start at least 30 minutes before their starting time, to allow enough time to complete any official documentation.

<u>Awards</u>

26 All finishers will receive a memento of the event.

Postponement or Cancellation

27 The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event or any part thereof should circumstance arise, which makes this desirable or necessary.
