

Sporting Car Club of Norfolk 2020 Micra Challenge



- This is a general description of the 2020 Micra Challenge points scoring.

- Points will either be automatically allocated, or in some cases will need to be claimed, to anyone using a Micra on anything SCCoN related in 2020 – Clubmans (aka Summer) Championship, 12 Car Championship, Marshalling, Stage Rally, Road Rally, Natter & Noggin, Spotlight articles, AGM, Dinner Dance, Midsummer Classic and anything missing from the list. The Coordinator's decision about anything will be final and it is the claimant's responsibility to make sure that the Challenge coordinator is aware of any claims.
- Only Full and Associate members of SCCoN can score Challenge points.
- All points to count towards the Challenge.

Challenge

- Winning a class on a SCCoN event driving a Micra 2 pc
- Driving on a SCCoN event in a Micra
- Driving to any event in a Micra
- Marshalling (driving to any event in a Micra)
- Marshalling (on a Micra SCCoN event)
- Spotlight article about or including Micras
- Clarification
 - Driving to and winning a class on a SCCoN event driving a Micra will ONLY score a maximum of 2 points
 - Driving to and marshalling on any event driving a Micra will ONLY score a maximum of 2 points
 - For Spotlight articles certain roles within the club require regular monthly articles, these will not count

Award

- The individual with the greatest number of points will be the Challenge Champion. In the event of a tie, the greater number of events attended will be used to decide the Champion. If a tie still stands then the final decision will be down to the SCCoN Club Chairman.
- The award will be known as the 'Joynt Trophy'.
