## **Midsummer Classic Car Run 2024 - Regulations**

### **Jurisdiction**

The event will be governed by the general regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations, and any further written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

### **Authorisations**

The event is organised under a Certificate of Exemption issued by Motorsport UK. Permit no. TBA

### **Eligibility**

The event is open to members of the public. The event is not a round of any championship

### **Timetable**

Entries open on publication of these regulations and close at 9pm on 16<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

### **Route and format**

The route will start just South West of Norwich

The route will be approximately 90 miles long and will include check points which will be specified in the Route Book given to each participant at the start of the run. check points will be open between specified times shown in the Route Book.

### **Definition**

- 1 The Midsummer Classic Car Run 2024 is a Touring Assembly for passenger cars.
- 2 The event, which is not competitive, will take place on Sunday June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2024
- 3 The organiser and promoter is the Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Limited
- 4 The event is organised under a Certificate of Exemption issued by Motorsport UK.
- 5 By applying to enter, all participants undertake to comply with these regulations and any additional instructions issued by the organisers. Such additional instructions will have the same power as these regulations.
- 6 The Event Managers have absolute discretion in the application and amendment of these regulations, a breach of which may result in exclusion from the event.

### **Eligible Vehicles**

7 The event is open to all three and four wheeled motor cars manufactured up to 2005. Cars manufactured after this date, heavily modified cars, kit cars, and light commercial vehicles may be accepted at the organisers' discretion. Such decisions will be based on an assessment of the interest of individual vehicles. Owners of such vehicles are requested to consult the organisers before

submitting their entry. Heavy commercial vehicles, agricultural vehicles and motorcycles are not normally permitted.

8 All vehicles must have valid insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act, a valid MOT Test certificate, and be licensed for use on the public road. Trade plates are not permitted. Each entrant is responsible for ensuring that their vehicle is in roadworthy condition.

9 The minimum number of entries is 50. If the minimum number is not achieved, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.

10 Participants will be provided with numbered identification plates, which must be displayed in a forward-facing position near the front of the car. No other numbers may be displayed, other than the vehicle registration number.

11 No advertising, trade sign or promotional display may be carried on or distributed from any vehicle without the organisers' consent.

### **Eligible Participants and Driver**

12 Entry may be made by any person over 17 years of age and who holds a full UK driver's license.

13 Only drivers named on the entry form may drive on the event.

14 Passengers may be carried up to the maximum number for which proper seating is provided.

### **Entries**

15 Entries open upon publication of these regulations and **close at 9pm on 16<sup>th</sup> June 2024.**

**The entry fee is £34.00.** The entry form is online at <http://www.scon.co.uk/html/classic/classic.html>

16 Entries must be made using the official entry form

17 Payment may be by Card/PayPal by BACS (SCCON's bank details are on the Entry Form), or by cheque. Cheques must be made payable to Sporting Car Club of Norfolk Ltd.

18 Acceptance of entries will be at the discretion of the organisers.

19 A request to withdraw from the event may be made via e-mail or in writing up to five days before the event. The entry fee will then be refunded less a £2 administration fee.

### **Documentation, Eligibility and Scrutineering**

20 By entering the event, entrants are declaring that, on the day of the event, their vehicle will be insured in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act for all persons who will drive the vehicle, will have a valid MOT test Certificate, will be taxed for use on the road, and that all persons who will drive hold a valid full driving licence for the vehicle to be driven.

21 In the week before the event, final instructions including directions to the start and starting times will be e-mailed to all participants.

22 Before starting the event and being given their Route Book, entrants must sign an indemnity form.

23 Any vehicle that does not comply with these regulations or is deemed inappropriate for the event will not be allowed to start.

### **Start**

24 Cars will leave the start at intervals with the first car departing at approx 09:30. Participants are requested to please try to arrive at the start 45 minutes before their starting time, to allow for the pre-event documentation and breakfast. Please try to stick to this as there will be restricted space and a steady through put will ensure a timely process.

### **Awards**

25 There will be no awards but all finishers will receive a gift at the end of the event.

### **Postponement or Cancellation**

26 The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the event or any part thereof should circumstances arise, which make this desirable or necessary.
